7. Authors verified the manuscript contents before submission:

- 7.1. Manuscripts should be prepared directly using EPPM-Journal's paper template (A4 size) (http://www.ppml.url.tw/EPPM_Journal/submission.htm).
- 7.2. Paper format should abide by the Journal's specifications that can be found in the paper template.
- 7.3. The citation and reference format should comply with the Journal's specifications.
- 7.4. Paper length is within 12 pages, including references. Paper length above 12 pages will be charged US\$100 per page.
- 7.5. The manuscript has corrected all grammatical, spelling, and punctuation mistakes.
- 7.6. The manuscript has been structured logically.
- 7.7. References mentioned in the text are listed in the reference section and vice versa.
- 7.8. The format of figures and tables can add clarity to the manuscript.
- 7.9. Permissions have been obtained to reuse copyrighted materials from other sources (including sources from the Internet).
- 7.10. The manuscript should be written with technical writing skills.
- 7.11. The manuscript should explain the novelty and contribution to the knowledge body.
- 7.12. A native speaker of English should proofread this manuscript. For non-native speakers of English, a proofread certificate is necessary before being fully accepted for publication.
- 7.13. The paper title should be concise and reflect the content of the paper without abbreviations.
- 7.14. The abstract should be concise and informative, addressing research motivation, objectives, method, process, and findings.
- 7.15. Two to five keywords are provided.
- 7.16. Research objectives, questions, and hypotheses should be discussed in the text.
- 7.17. All figures and tables include relevant captions and numbers, and the number is mentioned and discussed in the manuscript.
- 7.18. Every equation needs a number, and the number is mentioned and discussed in the manuscript.
- 7.19. The manuscript should clearly indicate theoretical development.
- 7.20. The manuscript should explain how to apply research results to different areas and countries.
- 7.21. The theoretical and practical implications of the results are adequately discussed.
- 7.22. Conclusions should be consistent with the results of the analysis/arguments.
- 7.23. Research limitations are noted.
- 7.24. The reference list should be up-to-date and contain important literature.
- 7.25. All necessary files have been uploaded.

8. Funding:

Authors are requested to identify financial support, if any, used in the execution of the research and preparation of the manuscript.

9. Institutional Review Board Statement:

Institutional Review Board (IRB) approval is necessary if manuscripts involve human subjects. Authors are requested to address IRB ID, approval date, and decision in this section. If IRB is not needed, please specify “not applicable.”

10. For revised and resubmitted manuscripts:

- 10.1. Reviewers’ and editors’ remarks are regarded as part of the review comments.
- 10.2. Duplicated sentences detected by the plagiarism software have to be rewritten.
- 10.3. A point-by-point explanation to review comments has been uploaded.
- 10.4. A track changes mode of revision has been uploaded.
- 10.5. The copyright transfer agreement has been signed by all authors and uploaded.
- 10.6. The authors’ portraits are clear with a plain background.
- 10.7. The author’s short autobiography should include the full first, middle and last names, educational background, work experience, research interests, membership in international or national organizations, and other important information.
